DISCUSSION	The Adoption Exchange focuses on trust based relationship intervention. Training is provided to professionals and caregivers. There are four classes – brain development, connection, implementation, and empowering principles. Jennifer will be doing an extended introduction class in Cheyenne Wells on January 31 st . She can offer services in Lincoln County as well. Training is for families who have achieved permanency after children have been returned home from DHS, are adoptive parents, or are providing kinship care and have custody of children. There is additional training for post permanency. The Adoption exchange has a state resource coordinator and has a lending library. Items are free of charge to use for up to a month. There are a lot of sensory tools available. All programs are free.

DISCUSSION	Julie reported that CKLECC staff had gotten everything moved to the new office space. Luci helped Julie find some free meeting chairs and they would be picked up later in the week. The Office of Early Childhood was awarded the Preschool Development Grant.
