A representative from OMNI will be there to sit down with us and help us put our plan together. All Committee members are encouraged to participate. Lunch will be provided.</p> <p>The remaining Buell Funds were used to create more totes for Plainview School. The totes were brought in so that the committee members could browse through and see all of the wonderful learning tools that are included.</p> <p>The Home Care Providers Appreciation in Cheyenne Wells: Haley &amp; Julie are planning a provider appreciation night in Cheyenne Wells on September 20<sup>th</sup> at the Community Building. They are hoping to setup an additional time to discuss Colorado Shines and training opportunities that we have available to them. There will possibly be a Representative there to speak about the Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP); and the availability to offer Face to Face Training with Colorado Shines Coach, Carole Spady will be discussed.</p> <p><b>Family Friend and Neighbor (FFN) Mini Grants:</b> Julie reported that the Early Childhood Council Leadership Alliance (ECCLA) is apply for the FFN funds again. There are trainings on PDIS that Carole is approved to provide Face to Face Trainings. Instead of receiving only one credit hour watching the video on PDIS, you receive 2</p>
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	<p>credit hours for attending a Face to Face Training. We need to decide what the needs of our providers are so we can put a training guide together and send it in to the state to be approved.</p> <p>Ideas that were discussed were: Social Emotional trainings; Sensory Disorders vs. Behavioral Issues to incorporate into Child Find; What type of evaluations are providers using for sensory disorders?</p>
