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## Child Care Provider Pre-Licensing Course in Limon

Becoming a licensed family child care provider involves much more than just "babysitting" for pay. It involves a commitment to provide care and education for the most valuable resource there is: our children. The Northeast Colorado Child Care Resource and Referral will be hosting a State of Colorado Approved Pre-Licensing Training in Limon on Friday, September 11th and Saturday,

September 12th from 8:30 a.m to 5:00 p.m. (must attend both days). The cost is \$85 per person and this includes supplies.

T.E.A.C.H. (Teacher Education and Compensation Helps) Early Childhood® provides comprehensive scholarships for coursework leading to degrees and credentials in early childhood education. More than just a scholarship program, T.E.A.C.H. is an important tool for providing low-income child care workers with an opportunity to improve their education, increase their earnings, and work toward self-sufficiency. In addition, numerous research studies have linked the education level of early childhood teachers with higher-quality care and improved outcomes for

children. Qualistar Colorado has administered the T.E.A.C.H. program in Colorado for the past 17 years, for the benefit of 2,000 educators and more than 200,000 children.

Colorado T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® currently provides eligible ECE professionals with scholarships that include:

- 90 percent of the tuition
  - Book reimbursement and travel stipend
  - Bonus upon successful completion of coursework
  - Paid release time to attend classes (in some cases).
