Beef Fried Rice Recipe

1 lb. boneless beef sirloin steak, thinly sliced

2 cups frozen stir-fry vegetables

1 cup fat-free reduced sodium chicken broth

3 Tbsp. Catalina Dressing

2 Tbsp. soy sauce

2 cups instant brown rice, uncooked

1 can (11 oz.) mandarin oranges, drained

1/3 cup chopped green onions

Cook meat in nonstick wok on high heat 3 min. or until evenly browned, stirring occasionally. Add next 5 ingredients; stir. Bring to boil; cover. Simmer 5 min. Remove from heat. Let stand 5 min. Add oranges and onions; fluff with fork. Note: If you don't have a wok, you can use a large skillet sprayed with cooking spray instead.


